## Vocational Learning Option (VLO) Semester 1 2019

The Auto mechanics VLO will deliver four units of competency from AUR20716 Certificate II in Automotive Vocational Preparation and is an introductory competency cluster in the automotive service and repair industry. The VLO provides students with basic skills and knowledge to assist in an automotive workshop. Students will receive a Statement of Attainment for competencies successfully completed, and will have the opportunity to continue their CIT Certificate II study into semester 2\*.
