## Vocational Learning Option (VLO)

### Semester 1 2019

The Early Childhood Education VLO will deliver four units of competency from the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care CHC30113 training package. Students will have the opportunity to gain knowledge and skills to assist in the planning of safe learning environments for young children as well as provide for their care. This VLO requires students to attend a 3-5 day work placement in a preschool during the VLO. Students will receive a Statement of Attainment for competencies successfully completed.
