NEW INFORMATION

Allergy Aware School

At Wanniassa School we are an 'Allergy Aware' school. This is to help provide protection for children who have severe allergic reactions and to support us in our commitment to providing a safe learning environment for all members of our school community. We have several students and staff across the junior campus with severe allergies. To assist us in keeping children safe within the school we ask that parents do not provide food for their children that contains nuts (including spreads such as Nutella).

Children and adults with severe nut allergies can experience an anaphylactic response by touch, contact with residue and by being in close vicinity to nuts, so although food is not shared, it is important that the contents of every student's lunchbox need to be nut-allergy friendly. Thank you for ongoing support.

Youth InterACT Scholarship

The Youth InterACT Scholarships provides funding of up to \$500 for individuals, or \$1,500 for groups of young people to participate in an activity, event or program. This may include online mental health, self-improvement programs or skills-based learning courses or training that enhances personal or career development, including participating in sporting activities, community or civic engagement activities or events.

Scholarships are available to young people aged 12 to 25 years who have a genuine ability and determination, but without financial assistance would struggle to attend their event or activity.
