Public Health Alert: protect against mosquito bites - Japanese encephalitis virus (JEV) has been detected in samples from pigs in commercial pig farms at locations in regional NSW, northern Vic and southern QLD indicating the virus is likely circulating in the mosquito population. There are no commercial pig farms in the ACT and JEV has not been detected in the ACT at this time. This virus is spread by mosquito bites and may affect animals, including pigs, and humans.
