NEW INFORMATION

Students leaving early - There has been a significant increase in the number of parents/carers asking for their child to be brought to the front office between 2:30-2:55pm each day. To ensure the smooth running of our school, please contact the front office before the 1pm lunch break so messages can be delivered to classrooms. Alternatively you can write a paper permission note to the classroom teacher or email the front office (Info.Wans@ed.act.edu.au) before the school day begins. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Students late to School - Parents and carers can bring students to the front office to sign them in again. If students sign themselves in late without a note, parent phone call or email explaining the late arrival, the absences will be recorded as unexplained and a text message will be sent to parents and carers.
