2024 Enrolments

ACT public school P-12 enrolments will open on Wednesday 26 April 2023. If your child currently attends our Preschool and does not reside within our PEA (Priority Enrolment Area) and wishes to continue at our Junior Campus in 2023, you must submit an enrolment form, further information on how to do this will be sent out to Preschool families early next term. Current Year 6 students who attend our Junior Campus are not required to submit an enrolment form if continuing at Wanniassa for Year 7.

Students leaving early

There has been a significant increase in the number of parents/carers asking for their child to be brought to the front office between 2:30-2:55pm each day. This makes it difficult for our front office staff to manage their normal duties, messages cannot always be delivered to students, and using the PA system disrupts everyone's learning.
