#### eSafety webinars for ACT public school parents and carers

#### 2023 NSW School travel applications are now open

Students who access NSW transport to attend ACT Schools and need a School Opal card or travel pass for 2023 can [apply](#) now. A new application will need to be submitted if they are applying for the first time, or if they are requesting an additional travel entitlement as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation. Students who change address, school, campus location, have repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should [renew or update](#) their details before the end of term 4. This will ensure that schools can endorse applications, and entitlements remain valid for the start of the 2023 school year.

### REMINDERS

#### Future of Education Equity Fund P-12 (expanding the Secondary Bursary Scheme)

Applications are now open for the Future of Education Equity Fund, which replaces the Secondary Bursary Scheme. The Equity Fund provides financial assistance to low-income families with students in years P-12. It helps cover the costs of education expenses through a one-off, annual payment for families with students enrolled in an ACT preschool (attached to a school) or school (as well as independent students). Payments of \$400 for preschool students, \$500 for primary school students and \$750 for high-school and college students are available to those who meet the eligibility criteria. Apply on the [SmartyGrants website](#). Families with students in years 7-10 who have already applied for financial assistance for the 2022 school year are not eligible for a second payment.
