REMINDERS

Future of Education Equity Fund P-12 (expanding the Secondary Bursary Scheme)

Applications are now open for the Future of Education Equity Fund, which replaces the Secondary Bursary Scheme. The Equity Fund provides financial assistance to low-income families with students in years P-12. It helps cover the costs of education expenses through a one-off, annual payment for families with students enrolled in an ACT preschool (attached to a school) or school (as well as independent students). Payments of \$400 for preschool students, \$500 for primary school students and \$750 for high-school and college students are available to those who meet the eligibility criteria. Families with students in years 7-10 who have already applied for financial assistance for the 2022 school year are not eligible for a second payment.
