K-6 After School Pick-Up Information

Covid visitor restrictions have been lifted and we are very happy to welcome parents, carers and visitors to morning lines under the COLA and to classrooms in the afternoon. If the afternoon pickup routine does not suit your family, please let us know. K-2 parents and carers will be asked for feedback later this term.

Kindergarten teachers will meet parents at Red Unit classroom door each afternoon while students settle into school. **Year 1 & 2** teachers will be available at their classrooms if parents would like to have a quick chat. Students will be dismissed from class to their pickup person (parent/carer, adults or older sibling).

Year 3-6 students will dismissed from their classroom and teachers will be available to talk to parents at the front of the school.

Before School Supervision

Direct supervision is provided for K-6 student from 8:45am each morning under the COLA, however staff are on site from 8:30am at both campuses and able to assist students if needed. Only students who access Before School Care should be on site before 8:30am. Please remind your child they can come to their campus Front Office if they need assistance at any time.

Preschool parents must accompany their child into the preschool classrooms at 9am to sign student in. No supervision or access to the classrooms can be granted before the program begins. Prior to 9am parents are welcome to access the outside areas of preschool playground and undercover areas.
